Sources for Wood

We are often asked, "Where do you get your wood?" Here are links to some of our favorite local sources. Let us know if we missed anyone.

<u>The Hardwood Centre</u>. Big supporters of MWWG and nice folks. Hardwoods, birch plywood, some veneers, and locally milled lumber. They are happy to order what they don't have.

<u>Crosscut in Eugene and Portland</u>. If the Hardwood Centre doesn't have it these folks have a larger selection and stock.

<u>Lewis Judy/Northwest Timber</u>. Also a long time supporter of MWWG. If you are looking for specially figured wood try here.

<u>Tree Products Eugene</u>. A good source for hardwood, veneered plywood and more.

Mike's Bargain Center. Discount lumber, some hardwoods, occasional treasures and deals.

Woodcraft Eugene. If you are looking for smaller turning blanks.

<u>Spaeth Lumber</u>. Construction lumber oriented. But if you need table saw or jointer/shaper blades sharpened they will send them to <u>Snooks Saw Service</u> in Salem for you with a short turn-around.
