Topic: Lecture - Nick Clark, A Woodworker's Journey from the UK to Corvallis.

In the first half Nick will describe how a "lad" from an English village who began his woodworking career in a traditional UK 5-year woodworking apprenticeship program at age 16 ended up a master woodworker in the Corvallis, Oregon area.

The second half of Nick's presentation will focus on his woodworking projects and the techniques he has refined over 40 years of furniture making and building high end cabinetry in the UK, Berkeley, CA, Ashland, OR and now the Corvallis area.

Those of you who have met Nick and seen his work know he is both an expert woodworker and an entertaining speaker. His museum talk should be an event that our membership, their families, friends and anyone with an interest in woodworking will enjoy attending.

February Meeting Recap

At our February 23 meeting of the Mid-Willamette Woodworkers Guild (MWWG), we were pleased to welcome Autumn Peterson as our featured presenter. Autumn, of Heritage Finishes and Summerbeam Books in Philomath, shared her deep knowledge of wood finishes in an engaging and highly practical session. Her presentation focused on helping woodworkers better understand how different finishes behave, how they protect wood, and how to make informed choices based on the needs of a project.



One of the key takeaways from the evening was that “oil has a harness”—in other words, oil finishes have limits. They penetrate the wood and enhance its natural beauty, but they do not create the same protective film that surface coatings provide. Autumn clearly explained the difference between penetrating oils and film finishes such as varnish or polyurethane. Penetrating oils soak into the fibers and offer a warm, natural look, while film finishes build a layer on top of the wood. She also noted that tung oil can slowly build up over the years with repeated applications, gradually increasing sheen and protection.

A helpful rule of thumb shared was “oil finishes with oil, water-based with water”—



meaning finishes generally bond best when similar types are used together. Applying oil over a fully cured water-based finish (or vice versa) can create adhesion challenges if not done properly. Members left with a clearer understanding of how finishes interact and greater confidence in choosing and applying the right finish for their next project.
